

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 01, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar

as of 28 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 24 October 2024 at around 11:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 01, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar. The fire was declared out at around 12:40 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **seven (7) families** or **27 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 01, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **16 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **five (5) houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 01, Quinapondan, Eastern Samar** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱63,916.16** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families by the **DSWD** (see Annex D).
