

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 145, Pasay City as of 18 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 11 October 2024 at around 4:42 PM, a fire incident occurred at Mahogany St. and Bacawan st. in Brgy. 145, Pasay City. The fire was declared out at around 6:02 PM.

A total of **75 families** or **251 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 145, Pasay City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **75 families** or **251 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. 145 Evacuation Center** in **Pasay City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **13 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 145, Pasay City** (see Annex C).
