I. Situation Overview

On 28 October 2024, a fire incident occurred at Gate 46, 48, and 50, Parola Compound, Brgy. 275, Zone 25, San Nicolas, Manila City.

A total of **88 families** or **316 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 275** in **San Nicolas**, **Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 88 families or 316 persons currently taking temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 88 houses were damaged; of which, 61 are totally damaged and 27 are partially damaged in Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City (see Annex C).
