





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Calaba, Bangued, Abra

as of 09 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 September 2024 at around 8:48 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Calaba, Bangued, Abra.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or three (3) persons are affected in Brgy. Calaba, Bangued, Abra (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or three (3) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Calaba, Bangued, Abra (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱25,750.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; composed of ₱8,000.00 from DSWD, ₱1,250.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and ₱16,500.00 from the Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) (see Annex D).
