

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Calaba, Bangued, Abra as of 09 October 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 September 2024 at around 8:48 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Calaba, Bangued, Abra.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

**One (1) family** or **three (3) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Calaba, Bangued, Abra** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

**One (1) family** or **three (3) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Calaba, Bangued, Abra** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱25,750.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; composed of **₱8,000.00** from **DSWD**, **₱1,250.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **₱16,500.00** from the **Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)** (see Annex D).
