





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City

as of 21 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 October 2024 at around 12:00 NN, a fire incident occurred at Purok 28, San Carlos Heights, Barangay Irisan, Baguio City.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or nine (9) persons are affected in Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or seven (7) persons are temporarily staying with their friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}60,174\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}18,174.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}42,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
