I. Situation Overview

On 14 October 2024 at around 2:29 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Magsaysay Village, La Paz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 3:58 PM.

A total of **27 families** or **135 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Magsaysay Village**, **La Paz**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 27 families or 135 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Iloilo Quarantine Facility in Brgy. Magsaysay Village, La Paz, Iloilo City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 19 houses were damaged; of which, 17 are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Magsaysay Village, La Paz, Iloilo City (see Annex C).
