



# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur

as of 29 October 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 15 October 2024 at around 4:05 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 6, Feelings Village, John Bosco District, Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 7:10 PM.

## **II.** Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **33 families** or **114 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are five (5) families or 20 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Mangagoy Evacuation Center in Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **28 families** or **94 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **33 families** or **114 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **20** houses were damaged; of which, **15** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

**P407,249.70** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
