

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Molopolo, Macrohon, Southern Leyte as of 21 October 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 28 September 2024 at around 6:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Fort San Pedro, Brgy. Veterans Village, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out on the same day.

A total of **three (3) families** or **eight (8) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Molopolo, Macrohon, Southern Leyte** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **eight (8) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Molopolo, Macrohon, Southern Leyte** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱24,064.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families by the **DSWD** (see Annex D).
