

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental

as of 04 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 September 2024 at around 2:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 2:15 PM.

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. North Poblacion, Medina, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱7,396.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱2,396.00** from **DSWD** and **₱5,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
