I. Situation Overview

On 12 October 2024 at around 9:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, Brgy. Payao, Catbalogan City, Samar.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 12 families or 53 persons are affected in Brgy. Payao, Catbalogan City, Samar (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are 12 families or 53 persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of nine (9) houses were damaged; of which, six (6) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Payao, Catbalogan City, Samar (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P13,740.00** worth of assistance was provided by LGU to the affected families. (see Annex D).
