I. Situation Overview

On 25 September 2024 at around 5:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kwang, Brgy. San Vicente, Medina, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 6:00 PM.

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. San Vicente, Medina, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. San Vicente, Medina, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱7,396.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱2,396.00 from DSWD, and ₱5,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
