A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Sto. Niño, Sulat, Eastern Samar (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P15,425.76** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families by the **DSWD** (see Annex D).
