I. Situation Overview

On 09 October 2024 at around 3:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Earth, Brgy. Telaje, Tandag City, Surigao del Sur.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **64 families** or **256 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Telaje**, **Tandag City**, **Surigao del Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 64 families or 256 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Covered Court in Brgy. Telaje, Tandag City, Surigao del Sur (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 61 houses were damaged; of which, 56 are totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged in Brgy. Telaje, Tandag City, Surigao del Sur (see Annex C).
