I. Situation Overview

On 11 October 2024 at around 6:40 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. VII, City of Vigan, Ilocos Sur.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **Six (6) families** or **16 persons** are affected in **Brgy. VII, City of Vigan, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. VII, City of Vigan, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱13,476.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
