

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Licab, Nueva Ecija

as of 13 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 October 2024, a flash flood incident occurred in Brgy. Aquino, Poblacion Sur, San Cristobal, San Juan, and Tabing-Ilog in Licab Nueva Ecija, which was caused by localized thunderstorms.

A total of **963 families** or **4,800 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Licab, Nueva Ecija** (see Annex A).

There are **12 families** or **45 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Tabing-Ilog Hall** in **Licab, Nueva Ecija** (see Annex B).
