

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Pikit, North Cotabato

as of 21 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 17 October 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) may brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 6:00 PM, several barangays in Municipality of Pikit, North Cotabato experienced flash flood incidents due to heavy rains caused by ITCZ.
