

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incidents in Libungan, North Cotabato as of 17 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 14 October 2024 at 4PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 10PM, several barangays in the municipality of Libungan, North Cotabato experienced flash flood incidents due to localized thunderstorms.
