

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Maguindanao del Sur

as of 03 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 26 August 2024 at 4:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Southwest Monsoon that may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 6:00 PM, several barangays in the municipalities of Ampatuan, Datu Saudi Ampatuan, Mamasapano, and Shariff Aguak in Maguindanao del Sur experienced flooding due to heavy rains brought by the Southwest Monsoon.

A total of **7,375 families** or **36,875 persons** are affected in **19 barangays** in **Maguindanao del Sur** (see Annex A).
