

DSWD DROMIC Report #12 on the Severe Tropical Storm “Kristine”

as of 27 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview


Severe Tropical Storm Kristine (Trami) exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) at 2 PM on Friday, October 25, while maintaining its strength as it continued to move west-southwestward over the West Philippine Sea its rainbands are expected to still affect parts of Luzon. Meanwhile, the possibility of re-entry to PAR in the following week is not ruled out.

Moreover, the southwesterly wind flow induced by both Severe Tropical Storm Kristine and Tropical Storm Kong-Rey, which is located outside the PAR, will generate strong to gale-force gusts in certain regions of the country. According to the PAGASA bulletin issued at 11 AM today, Tropical Storm Kong-Rey is currently moving westward at a speed of 30 kilometers per hour (kph). Once it enters the PAR, it will be designated with the local name "Leon."

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,556,271 families** or **6,081,689 persons** are affected in **9,360 barangays** in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, CAR, and BARMM** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **93,377 families** or **351,857 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **2,834 evacuation centers** in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, XII, Caraga, and CAR** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **49,252 families** or **178,648 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **142,555 families** or **530,177 persons** still displaced in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, and CAR** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **18,032 houses** were damaged; of which, **966** are **totally damaged** and **17,066** are **partially damaged** in **Regions I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, and CAR** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱286,686,740.41** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱266,480,675.13** from **DSWD**, **₱18,281,637.56** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱1,631,880.00** from the **Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)**, and **₱292,547.72** from **other Partners** (see Annex H).
