
I. Situation Overview

On 25 October 2024, Severe Tropical Storm (STS) “Kristine” exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,771,683 families** or **6,907,980 persons** are affected in **10,239 barangays** in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, CAR, and BARMM** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **70,992 families** or **266,075 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **2,327 evacuation centers** in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, XII, and Caraga** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **100,332 families** or **461,783 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **171,324 families** or **727,858 persons** still displaced in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, and CAR** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **33,308 houses** were damaged; of which, **3,204** are **totally damaged** and **30,104** are **partially damaged** in **Regions I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, and CAR** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱387,692,566.24** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱364,225,334.30** from **DSWD**, **₱21,246,289.22** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱1,668,055.00** from the **Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)**, and **₱302,887.72** from **other Partners** (see Annex H).
