

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) in Tantangan, South Cotabato as of 17 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 26 September 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by ITCZ may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Visayas and Mindanao.

On the same day at around 3:00 PM, several barangays in the municipality of Tantangan, South Cotabato experienced flash floods and strong winds due to the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **668 families** or **3,340 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Tantangan, South Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **seven (7) families** or **35 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **47 houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **40** are **partially damaged** in **Tantangan, South Cotabato** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱740,144.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
