





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorm in Mindanao

as of 28 October 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 15 October 2024 at around 9:00 AM, several municipalities in Maguindanao del Sur experienced incidents of flash flood due to the continuous heavy rainfall brought by localized thunderstorms. On the same day at around 3:00 PM, a flash flood incident was also experienced in Lutayan, North Cotabato due to the same localized thunderstorms.
