

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City

as of 04 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 October 2024, a fire incident occurred at Gate 46, 48, and 50, Parola Compound, Brgy. 275, Zone 25, San Nicolas, Manila City.

A total of **99 families** or **357 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 275 in San Nicolas, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **99 families** or **357 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Delpa Sports Complex** in **Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **88 houses** were damaged; of which, **61** are **totally damaged** and **27** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 275, San Nicolas, Manila City** (see Annex C).
