

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak San Nicolas, Cebu City

as of 29 October 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 27 October 2024 at around 12:26 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Isla Alegre, Brgy. Basak San Nicolas, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 3:25 AM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **181 families** or **723 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Basak San Nicolas, Cebu City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **181 families** or **723 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Basak Community Elementary School** in **Brgy. Basak San Nicolas, Cebu City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **118 houses** were damaged; of which, **96** are **totally damaged** and **22** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak San Nicolas, Cebu City** (see Annex E).
