## **DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Boulevard, Molo, Iloilo City**

as of 06 November 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 28 October 2024 at around 11:57 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 1, Brgy. Boulevard, Molo, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 1:05 AM.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **13 families** or **65 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Boulevard, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **eight (8) families** or **40 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Boulevard, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **five (5) families** or **25 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **13 families** or **65 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Boulevard, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex D).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **13 houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **eight (8)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Boulevard, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Annex E).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱29,289.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
