

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Magsaysay Village, La Paz, Iloilo City as of 16 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 October 2024 at around 2:29 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Magsaysay Village, La Paz, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 3:58 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **55 families** or **109 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Magsaysay Village, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **55 families** or **109 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Magsaysay Village, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **21 houses** were damaged; of which, **18** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Magsaysay Village, La Paz, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱461,495.84** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
