

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Concepcion, Asuncion, Davao del Norte

as of 31 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 13 October 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to some areas in the country. On the same day, Brgy. Concepcion, Asuncion, Davao del Norte experienced a flash flood incident due to localized thunderstorms.
