





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Zeneben, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat

as of 23 October 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 16 October 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 1:00 PM, Brgy. Zeneben, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat experienced flash flood incident due to heavy rains brought by localized thunderstorms.
