





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Effects of Easterlies

as of 10 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 October 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur and Banaybanay, Davao Oriental experienced flooding due to the Easterlies.


On 02 October 2024, the Easterlies caused flooding in various municipalities in the province of Maguindanao del Sur.

On 03 October 2024, flashflood incidents were also experienced in the municipalities of Arakan, North Cotabato and Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **37,689 families** or **165,372 persons** are affected in **81 barangays** in **Regions XI, XII,** and **BARMM** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **26 families** or **117 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Malibatuan Covered** in **Region XII** (see Annex B).







b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **25 families** or **61 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 51 families or 178 persons displaced in Region XII (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **13** are **partially damaged** in **Region XII** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}798,833.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}782,933.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}15,900.00\$ from the Local Government Units (LGUs) (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱122.41 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱6 million available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- ₱41.6 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of Easterlies.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 450,881 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 203,116 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 247,765 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 213,405 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- 1.34 million FFPs in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of Easterlies.
- ₱1.2 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FOS warehouses.
