



DSWD DROMIC Report #57 on Kanlaon Volcano Eruption

as of 29 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

As of **29 November 2024**, Kanlaon Volcano remains under **Alert Level 2** indicating increasing unrest.

On 03 June 2024 at 8:00 PM, Alert Level 2 was raised for Kanlaon Volcano after a moderately explosive eruption occurred at the summit crater. Subsequent observations were recorded over the Kanlaon Volcano throughout June, July, August, and September noting heightened seismic activity, ground deformation, and elevated sulfur dioxide emissions.

The public is urged to remain vigilant and refrain from entering the four-kilometerradius Permanent Danger Zone (PDZ) to mitigate risks associated with volcanic hazards, including pyroclastic flows and rockfalls. In the event of ash fall, individuals should protect their respiratory health by using damp cloths or dust masks.

Civil aviation authorities are advised to instruct pilots to avoid the vicinity of the volcano due to the potential dangers posed by ash and projectiles. Additionally, communities near river systems on the southern and western slopes should take precautions in anticipation of heavy rainfall, particularly those that have previously experienced lahars or muddy flows.


II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **17,371 families** or **57,563 persons** are affected in **23 barangays** in **Regions VI** and **VII** (see Annex A).









III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **10 families** or **30 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Masulog Covered Gymnasium** in **La Castellana, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **176 families** or **631 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population
 There are 10 families or 30 persons still displaced in La Castellana, Negros
 Occidental (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **2,680 houses** were **partially damaged** in **La Castellana, Negros Occidental** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱54,944,095.67 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱38,143,932.28 is from the DSWD, ₱4,674,678.97 from the Local Government Units (LGUs), ₱2,491,000.00 from Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) and ₱9,634,484.92 from other Partners (see Annex H).
