

## DSWD DROMIC Report #7 on the Severe Tropical Storm “Kristine” as of 24 October 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 24 October 2024 at 5PM, “Kristine” is now over the coastal waters of Southern Ilocos Sur.

#### HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

##### Heavy Rainfall Outlook

Refer to Weather Advisory No. 22 issued at 5:00 PM today for the heavy rainfall outlook due to “Kristine”.


##### Severe Winds

The wind signals warn the public of the general wind threat over an area due to the tropical cyclone. Local winds may be slightly stronger/enhanced in coastal and upland/mountainous areas exposed to winds. Winds are less strong in areas sheltered from the prevailing wind direction.

- Moderate to significant impacts from storm-force winds are possible within any of the localities where Wind Signal No. 3 is hoisted.
- Minor to moderate impacts from gale-force winds are possible within any of the localities where Wind Signal No. 2 is hoisted
- Minimal to minor impacts from strong winds are possible within any of the areas under Wind Signal No. 1.

Furthermore, the wind flow coming towards the circulation of “Kristine” and the Northeasterly Windflow will also bring strong to gale-force gusts over the following areas (especially in coastal and upland areas exposed to winds):

- Today (24 October): The rest of the country outside Wind Signal areas
- Tomorrow (25 October): MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, Visayas, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte, Northern Mindanao, Zamboanga Peninsula, BARMM, SOCCSKSARGEN, and Davao Region.
- Saturday (26 October): MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, Western Visayas, Negros Island Region, Zamboanga Norte, Siquijor, Bohol, Camiguin, Surigao del Norte, Dinagat Islands.



## Coastal Inundation


There is a minimal to moderate risk of storm surge with peak heights of around 1.0 to 2.0 m above normal tide levels in the next 48 hours over the low-lying or exposed coastal localities of Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, Cagayan, Isabela, Aurora, and Zambales.

The center of the eye of Severe Tropical Storm “Kristine” was estimated based on all available data over the coastal waters of Santa Lucia, Ilocos Sur (17.1°N, 120.2°E) moving Westward slowly with a maximum sustained winds of 95 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 115 km/h.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **620,364 families** or **2,644,830 persons** are affected in **3,803 barangays** in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CAR, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XII** and **BARMM** (see Annex A).



## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **60,720 families** or **219,457 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **2,538 evacuation centers** in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CAR, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, XII, and CARAGA** (see Annex B).

**b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **17,714 families** or **70,331 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

**c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **78,434 families** or **289,788 persons** still displaced in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XII, Caraga, and CAR** (see Annex F).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **709 houses** were damaged; of which, **95** are **totally damaged** and **614** are **partially damaged** in **Regions I, III, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VIII, IX, X, XII, Caraga, and CAR** (see Annex G).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱67,093,334.36** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱65,019,421.09** from **DSWD**, **₱1,569,063.27** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, and **₱89,500.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex H).
