

DSWD DROMIC Report #9 on the Severe Tropical Storm “Kristine” as of 25 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 25 October 2024 at 5 PM, “Kristine” accelerates outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

Heavy Rainfall Outlook

Refer to Weather Advisory No. 27 issued at 11 AM today for the heavy rainfall outlook due to the Southwesterly Wind Flow associated with “Kristine”.

Severe Winds

The wind signals warn the public of the general wind threat over an area due to the tropical cyclone. Local winds may be slightly stronger/enhanced in coastal and upland/mountainous areas exposed to winds. Winds are less strong in areas sheltered from the prevailing wind direction.

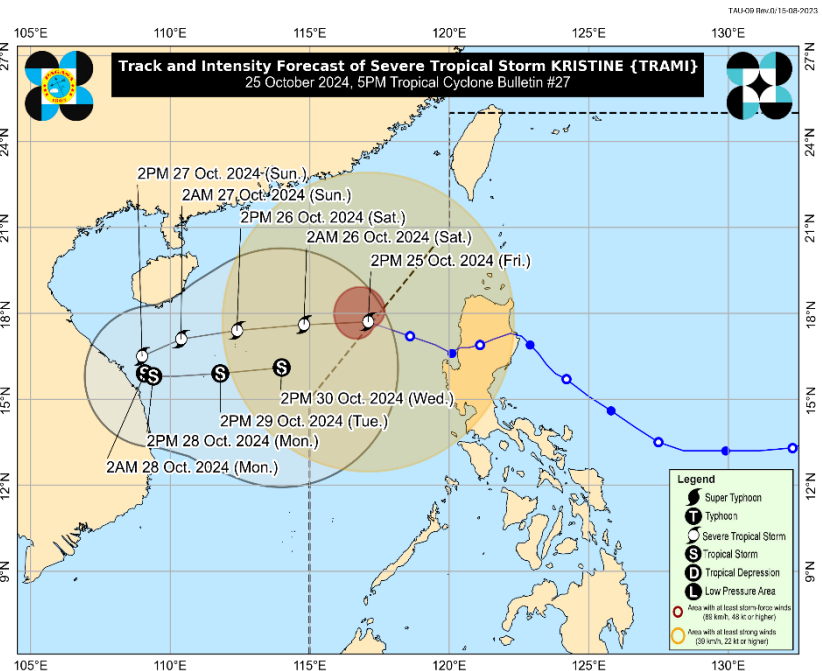
- Minimal to minor impacts from strong winds are possible within any of the areas under Wind Signal No. 1.

Furthermore, the southwesterly wind flow triggered by both “Kristine” and Tropical Storm “Kong-Rey” outside the PAR region will also bring strong to gale-force gusts over the following areas (especially in coastal and upland areas exposed to winds):
 Today (25 October): MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, Visayas, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Norte, Northern Mindanao, Zamboanga Peninsula, BARMM, SOCCSKSARGEN, and Davao Region

- Tomorrow (26 October): Palawan, Romblon, Western Visayas, Negros Island Region, Siquijor, Bohol, Southern Leyte, Zamboanga del Norte, Camiguin, Dinagat Islands, and Surigao del Norte.
- Sunday (27 October): Palawan, Romblon, Visayas, Zamboanga del Norte, Camiguin, Dinagat Islands, and Surigao del Norte.

Coastal Inundation

All Storm Surge Warnings have been lifted.



HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

A Gale Warning is hoisted over the northern and western seaboard of Luzon.

24-Hour Sea Condition Outlook

Up to very rough or high seas over the following coastal waters:

- Up to 6.0 m: The western seaboard of Pangasinan, Zambales, and Bataan.
- Up to 5.5 m: The remaining seaboard of Pangasinan; the seaboard of Batanes, Babuyan Island, and La Union.
- Up to 5.0 m: The remaining seaboard of Ilocos Region; the eastern seaboard of mainland Cagayan; the seaboard of Lubang Islands; the western seaboard of Bataan and Batangas.
- Up to 4.5 m: The seaboard of Occidental Mindoro; the northern and western seaboard of Calamian Islands.
- Sea travel is risky for all types or tonnage of vessels. All mariners must remain in port or, if underway, seek shelter or safe harbor as soon as possible until winds and waves subside.

Up to rough seas over the following coastal waters:

- Up to 4.0 m: The remaining seaboard of Cagayan Valley; the western seaboard of mainland Palawan; the seaboard of Kalayaan Islands.
- Up to 3.5 m: The seaboard of Cuyo Islands, Calamian Islands, Antique, and northern Aurora; the southern seaboard of Iloilo; the western and southern seaboard of Guimaras; the western and southern seaboard of Negros Occidental.
- Up to 3.0 m: The remaining seaboard of Aurora and Batangas; the seaboard of Oriental Mindoro, Marinduque, Romblon, Camarines Norte; the northern seaboard of Camarines Sur, the northern and eastern seaboard of Polillo.
- Mariners of small seacrafts, including all types of motorbancas, are advised not to venture out to sea under these conditions, especially if inexperienced or operating ill-equipped vessels.

Up to moderate seas over the following coastal waters:

- Up to 2.5 m: The seaboard of Northern Mindanao, Zamboanga del Norte, and Siquijor, the southern seaboard of Bohol, the eastern seaboard of Albay, Sorsogon, Eastern Samar, Dinagat Islands, Surigao del Sur, and Davao Oriental, the northern and eastern seaboard of Northern Samar.
- Mariners of motorbancas and similarly-sized vessels are advised to take precautionary measures while venturing out to sea and, if possible, avoid navigation under these conditions.

TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK

- “Kristine” will continue moving westward over the West Philippine Sea until tomorrow, loop counterclockwise on Sunday and Monday, then move eastward for the remainder of the forecast period. However, this scenario heavily depends on the behavior of the tropical cyclone east of the PAR region and the behavior of

other synoptic weather systems surrounding “Kristine” while over the West Philippine Sea.

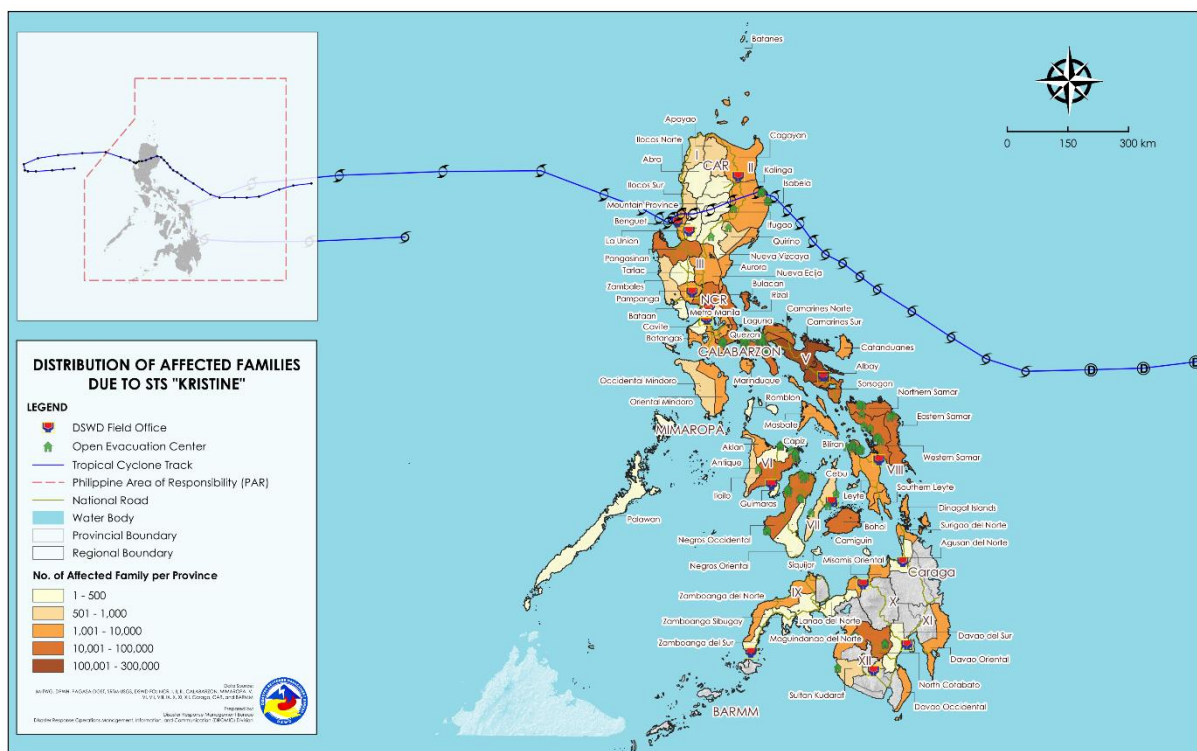
- This tropical cyclone is forecast to gradually intensify over the West Philippine Sea. While it is likely that the tropical cyclone will remain at severe tropical storm category within the next two days, the chance for it to be upgraded into a typhoon is not ruled out. However, a weakening trend is expected by early next week due to a possible surge of northeasterly wind flow over the West Philippine Sea.

The center of Severe Tropical Storm “Kristine” was estimated based on all available data at 410 km West of Sinit, Ilocos Sur (outside PAR) (17.7 °N, 116.6 °E) moving Westward at 30 km/h with a maximum sustained winds of 95 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 115 km/h.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **880,009 families** or **3,610,447 persons** are affected in **6,188 barangays** in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CAR, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, BARMM**, and **Caraga** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **92,700 families** or **337,796 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **3,760 evacuation centers** in **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CAR, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, XII**, and **Caraga** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **50,115 families** or **188,823 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **141,727 families** or **522,613 persons** still displaced **Regions NCR, I, II, III, CAR, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, and Caraga** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **4,957 houses** were damaged; of which, **418** are **totally damaged** and **4,539** are **partially damaged** in **Regions I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, and CAR** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱123,826,100.80** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱117,028,533.16** from **DSWD**, **₱6,662,214.92** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱6,310.00** from the **Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)**, **₱129,042.72** from **other Partners** (see Annex H).
