



DSWD DROMIC Report on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Bokod, Benquet

16 October 2024, 6PM

Ι. Situation Overview

Issued on 24 August 2024, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by the Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, provinces of Abra, Benguet, and portions of Ifugao and Mountain Province experienced strong wind and heavy rains brought by the Localized Thunderstorms, which caused the Ambangeg-Badabak Provincial Road to partially collapse.

On 01 September 2024, said provincial road totally collapsed, which affected the income of the residents / farmers in Brgy. Bila, Ekip, and Poblacion. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) CAR and DOST-PAGASA Daily Weather Bulletin

Status of Affected Areas and Population П.

A total of 745 families or 3,373 persons were affected in three (3) barangays in Bokod, Benguet (see Table 1).
