

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Grebona, Libungan, North Cotabato

17 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 01 October 2024 at 4AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 3PM, a flash flood incident was experienced in Brgy. Grebona, Libungan, North Cotabato due to localized thunderstorms.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XII, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.
