

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flash Flood Incident in City of San Jose del Monte, Bulacan

03 February 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 30 August 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in some parts of the country.

On the same day, a flash flood incident was experienced in Brgy. Citrus, Brgy. Bagong Buhay II, Brgy. Sapang Palay Proper, and Brgy. Assumption in the City of San Jose del Monte, Bulacan.

A total of **364 families** or **1,126 persons** were affected in **four (4) barangays** in the **City of San Jose del Monte, Bulacan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **two (2) families** or **16 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Culianin Covered Court** in **Plaridel, Bulacan** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱271,562.20** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
