





DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flooding Incident in Palawan

19 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 March 2022, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms caused by the Low Pressure Area (LPA) may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to scattered light to moderate to at times heavy rains in Palawan.

On the same day, several barangays in the municipalities of Narra and Puerto Princesa City in Palawan experienced flooding.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **459 families** or **1,903 persons** were affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Palawan** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **109 families** or **547 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Palawan** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **350 families** or **1,356 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **459 families** or **1,903 persons** were displaced in **Palawan** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **34 houses** were damaged; of which, **16** are **totally damaged** and **18** are **partially damaged** in **Palawan** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱154,590.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex F).
