
DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Acute Viral Hepatitis A Outbreak in Brgy. Camangcamang, Isabela, Negros Occidental

I. Situation Overview

In February 2024, the Municipal Health Office (MHO) of Isabela, Negros Occidental, began receiving reports of a locally spreading disease that eventually developed into an outbreak diagnosed as Acute Viral Hepatitis A in an isolated area of Sitio Mantabanon, Barangay Camangcamang, Isabela, Negros Occidental.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.
