

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental

27 January 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 October 2024 at 10:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 79th Infantry Battalion of Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of The Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental.

A total of **100 families** or **371 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Covered Gym** in **Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱61,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
