





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorm in Mindanao

30 November 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 October 2024 at around 9:00 AM, several municipalities in Maguindanao del Sur experienced incidents of flash flood due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by localized thunderstorms. On the same day at around 3:00 PM, a flash flood incident was also experienced in Lutayan, North Cotabato due to the same localized thunderstorms.

A total of **14,786 families** or **73,873 persons** were affected in **28 barangays** in **Regions XII** and **BARMM** (see Table 1).
