

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur

25 November 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 15 October 2024 at around 4:05 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 6, Feelings Village, John Bosco District, Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur. The fire was declared out at around 7:10 PM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **33 families** or **114 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **five (5) families** or **20 persons** sought temporary shelter at **Mangagoy Evacuation Center** in **Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **28 families** or **94 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **33 families** or **114 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **20 houses** were damaged; of which, **15 are totally damaged** and **five (5) are partially damaged** in **Brgy. Mangagoy, City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,679,249.70** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱407,249.70** from **DSWD**, **₱896,500.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱375,500.00** from **Non-Government Offices (NGOs)** (see Annex F).
