





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. VII, City of Vigan, Ilocos Sur

20 October 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 11 October 2024 at around 6:40 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. VII, City of Vigan, Ilocos Sur.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of six (6) families or 16 persons were affected in Brgy. VII, City of Vigan, Ilocos Sur (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or two (2) persons are currently taking temporary shelter at the Collado Hotel Evacuation Center in Brgy. Pantay Fatima, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **five (5) families** or **14 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex C).

## c. Total Displaced Population

One (1) family or two (2) persons are still displaced in Brgy. Pantay Fatima, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of four (4) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. VII, City of Vigan, Ilocos Sur (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}383,019.12\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}96,523.12\$ from **DSWD** and \$\mathbb{P}286,496.00\$ from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex F).
