

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Malabon City

03 February 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 June 2024, the Malabon-Navotas Flood Gate was damaged which caused flooding in Malabon City. Although the flooding subsided minutes or hours after, the properties and livelihood of the families living in the flooded areas were still affected.

A total of **500 families or 713 persons** were affected in **Malabon City** (see Annex A).

A total of **500 families or 713 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

A total of **₱346,290.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
