I. Situation Overview

On 20 October 2024, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1, Brgy. Proper Langcagan, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 11:22 AM.

There are **five (5) families** or **16 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of Five (5) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Proper Langcangan, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P10,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
