I. Situation Overview

On 20 October 2024, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1, Brgy. Proper Langcangan, Oroquieta City, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 11:22 AM.

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱10,000.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
