There are **73 families** or **365 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. 128, Zone 10, Balut, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

A total of **18 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 128, Zone 10, Balut, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).
