



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City

as of 29 November 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 November 2024 at around 9:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at 1697 LRC, 919 Quezon Boulevard in Brgy. 310, Zone 31, Santa Cruz, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:25 AM on 28 November 2024.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **496 families** or **1,385 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **496 families** or **1,385 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Bascom Covered Court** in **Brgy. 310, Santa Cruz, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **419** houses were damaged; of which, **415** are totally damaged and four **(4)** are partially damaged in Brgy. **310**, Santa Cruz, Manila City (see Annex C).

DSWD FO NCR ensured the availability of FNIs for possible augmentation. DSWD FO NCR continuously coordinated with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City through its Manila Department of Social Welfare for significant updates and any requests for augmentation.
