

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Anahaway, Palo, Leyte as of 01 November 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 October 2024 at around 12:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Anahaway, Palo, Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or **seven (7) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Anahaway, Palo, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **seven (7) persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Anahaway, Brgy. Hall in Palo, Leyte** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in **Brgy. Anahaway, Palo, Leyte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱18,891.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of **₱8,891.00** from **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
