I. Situation Overview

On 28 October 2024 at around 12:10 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Anahaway, Palo, Leyte.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or seven (7) persons are affected in Brgy. Anahaway, Palo, Leyte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or seven (7) persons currently taking temporary shelter in Brgy. Anahaway, Brgy. Hall in Palo, Leyte (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Anahaway, Palo, Leyte (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}18,891.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of \$\mathbb{P}8,891.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}10,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
