

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Caray-Caray, Naval, Biliran as of 13 November 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 12 November 2024 at around 11:32 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 2, Brgy. Caray-Caray, Naval, Biliran. The fire was declared out the next day at around 12:28 AM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **12 families** or **57 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Caray-Caray, Naval, Biliran** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **11 families** or **55 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Covered Court** in **Brgy. Caray-Caray, Naval, Biliran** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Caray-Caray, Naval, Biliran** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱217,156.56** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
